

INSTRUCTIONS TO TMFSF SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

Please read and follow these instructions carefully.

Incomplete applications and those received after the deadline will be disqualified.

The Thomas Munson Foundation Scholarship Fund, Inc., awards one-time scholarships annually to qualified high school seniors and first-time, freshman undergraduate students enrolled full time at an accredited institution, or program of higher education, at the 2-year or 4-year undergraduate, or vocational level, located in the United States. Applicants must be a citizen of the United States, and must be able to provide evidence of lineal descent from one of the signatories of the FUNDAMENTAL AGREEMENT OF 1639 FOR THE GOVERNANCE OF THE NEWLY ESTABLISHED NEW HAVEN COLONY. Although the awards are based heavily on financial need, an applicant's academic achievement and participation in extracurricular and community activities are also considered in the evaluation process. Upon verification of enrollment, the scholarship award money is paid directly to the academic institution, to be credited to the recipient's account for tuition and fees.

Please complete the application as follows:

1. Type or print all information on the application form.
2. Attach to the form a one-page typed personal statement of your goals and aspirations.
3. Include a copy of the family's Student Aid Report (SAR), a summarization of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
4. Arrange to have the following documents sent by the deadline, under separate cover directly from the source, to the address below:
 - a. Two letters of recommendation, one from a school official (classroom teacher, counselor, or administrator) and one from a non-family community member.
 - b. An official copy of your high school transcript and a copy of your college transcript if you are a first-year undergraduate student. Transcripts should contain courses completed and grades earned, including mid-term grades of the current scholastic year.
5. Submit evidence of lineal descent from one of the signatories of the FUNDAMENTAL AGREEMENT OF 1639 FOR THE GOVERNANCE OF THE NEWLY ESTABLISHED NEW HAVEN COLONY. A list of the signatories follows. Thomas Munson is the 6th name under the autograph signatures in column 2.
6. All application materials **must arrive** at the address below no later than **March 1, 2016**.
